## SANITATION HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

In 2018 Sanitation will observe the following holidays:

- New Year's Day (01/01/18)
- Martin Luther King, Jr. (01/15/18)
- President's Day (02/19/18)
- Memorial Day (05/28/18)
- Independence Day (07/04/18)
- Labor Day (09/03/18)
- Columbus Day (10/08/18)
- Veteran's Day (11/12/18)
- Thanksgiving Day (11/22/18)
- Christmas Day (12/25/18)

Sanitation/recycling collection will be **delayed one day** following the above holidays, which means crews will work Saturdays in those holiday weeks.

- By City Ordinance, all trash should be placed out for collection no more than 24 hours in advance or left out more than 24 hours after collection. Trash must be in the black City trash carts for collection.
- **CHRISTMAS TREES** (real wood) are collected for mulching and can be placed at the front curb until January 31<sup>st</sup>.
- **YARD WASTE** should be placed for pickup on Street Cleaning day, March 1<sup>st</sup> through December 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - Woody Waste – tree trimmings, shrubs, garden residue should be bundled & tied, less than 4' long and weigh less than 40 pounds
    - No dirt, bricks, concrete, etc.
  - Leaves must now be in paper bags. Plastic bags will not be picked up
  - During the winter months, bags of yard waste can be dropped off at the Public Works building
- **STREET MAINTENANCE** is conducted year round. Please observe the No Parking signs in your neighborhood.
  - **SWEEPING** is done by **Capital Region Water**, May 1<sup>st</sup> through December 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - **LEAF REMOVAL & WINTER MAINTENANCE** is still handled by the City.
- **BULK ITEMS** can be placed with your trash (one item per week) for collection.

## Recycling Guidelines



### **DO NOT Place in Recycling Container**

- Any type of glass bottles & jars
- Windows, mirrors, ceramics
- Full aerosol & paint cans
- Metal or electronic parts
- Food waste, litter, diapers
- Containers with food inside
- Aluminum foil & plastic bags



### **PLEASE Place in Recycling Container**

- Plastic containers & bottles #1 - #7
- Aluminum & steel cans & food containers
- Rinse and remove caps from all items
- Paper of all types (Newspaper or magazines tied or in a paper bag)
- Cardboard, phone books
- Dry, empty paint & aerosol cans

## **RECYCLABLES ARE NOT TO BE PLACED IN PLASTIC BAGS**

### **“COVERED DEVICE RECYCLING ACT”**

As of 2013, ALL electronics, televisions, computers, monitors, and computer peripherals MUST be recycled. These items and many others can be taken to the Dauphin County Recycling Center. For more information, please call 717-982-6772.
