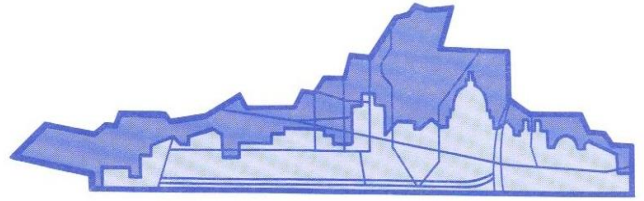

Scientific Name Common Name Suggested varieties/cultivars and additional notes

Small Trees (under 30') – Best for under utility lines and small planting areas

<i>Acer buergerianum</i>	Trident Maple	
<i>Acer campestre</i>	Hedge Maple	
<i>Acer tartaricum</i> ssp. <i>ginnala</i>	Amur Maple	
<i>Acer truncatum</i>	Shangtung Maple	
<i>Amelanchier canadensis</i>	Serviceberry	Single-stem tree form only
<i>Cercis canadensis</i>	Eastern Redbud	
<i>Cornus mas</i>	Cornelian Cherry Dogwood	Single-stem tree form only
<i>Chionanthus retusus</i>	Fringe tree	Single –stem tree form only
<i>Crataegus</i>	Hawthorn	Use thorn less varieties only
<i>Malus</i>	Crabapple	'Sugar Tyme', 'Profusion', 'Prariefire' 'Spring Snow'
<i>Prunus</i> 'Okame'	Okame Cherry	
<i>Prunus sargentii</i>	Sargent Cherry	'Accolade', 'Columnaris'
<i>Prunus</i> 'Snow Goose'	Snow Goose Cherry	
<i>Syringa reticulata</i>	Tree Lilac	'Ivory Silk', 'Regent', 'Summer Snow'

Medium Sized Trees (Under 45')

<i>Carpinus betulus</i>	European Hornbeam	'Fasitigata'
<i>Carpinus carolina</i>	American Hornbeam	
<i>Cladrastis kentukea</i>	Yellowwood	
<i>Koelreuteria paniculata</i>	Golden Raintree	
<i>Corylus colurna</i>	Tree Filbert	
<i>Parrotia persica</i>	Persian Parrotia	Single-stem tree form only

Large Trees (45' and over)

<i>Acer rubrum</i>	Red Maples	Many cultivars and varieties available. Do not plant Silver, Norway, or Sycamore maples
<i>Acer saccharum</i>	Sugar Maples	Many cultivars and varieties available. Do not plant where deicing materials are used heavily
<i>Cercidiphyllum japonicum</i>	Katsura	
<i>Ginko biloba</i>	Ginko, Maiden hair	'Autumn Gold', 'Princeton Sentry'
<i>Gleditsia triacanthos</i> var <i>intermis</i>	Honey Locust	'Shademaster', 'Imperial', 'Skyline'
<i>Gymnocladus dioicus</i>	Kentucky Coffee tree	

<i>Liliodendron tulipifera</i>	Tulip tree	
<i>Liquidamber styraciflua</i>	Sweetgum	'Cherokee', 'Rotundiloba'
<i>Metasequoia glyptostroboides</i>	Dawn Redwood	
<i>Nyssa Sylvatica</i>	Blackgum	
<i>Platanus x acerifolia</i>	London Plane tree	'Bloodgood'
<i>Quercus</i>	Oaks	Many varieties available, bur oak and swamp white oak are suggested, do not plant pin oak or red oak
<i>Tilia americana</i>	American Linden	
<i>Ulmus cultivars</i>	Elm Hybrids	'Native Charm', 'Triumph', 'Accolade', 'Valley Forge'
<i>Zelkova serrata</i>	Zelkova	'Green Vase', 'Musashino', 'Village Green'

Trees best for downtown sidewalk plantings

<i>Acer buergerianum</i>	Trident Maple	
<i>Acer campestre</i>	Hedge Maple	
<i>Acer tartaricum</i> ssp. <i>ginnala</i>	Amur Maple	
<i>Acer truncatum</i>	Shangtung Maple	
<i>Carpinus betulus</i>	European Hornbeam	'Fasitigata'
<i>Chionanthus retusus</i>	Fringe tree	Single –stem tree form only
<i>Crataegus</i>	Hawthorn	Use thorn less varieties only
<i>Koelreuteria paniculata</i>	Golden Raintree	
<i>Ginkgo biloba</i>	Ginkgo, Maiden hair	'Autumn Gold', 'Princeton Sentry'
<i>Gleditsia triacanthos</i> var <i>intermis</i>	Honey Locust	'Shademaster', 'Imperial', 'Skyline'
<i>Syringa reticulata</i>	Tree Lilac	'Ivory Silk', 'Regent', 'Summer Snow'

NOTE: Other species and varieties are acceptable for planting in city parks. Call or email city arborist with any questions regarding other acceptable tree species/varieties, planting locations, site conditions, etc.
