PUBLIC COMMENT REVIEW PERIOD & PUBLIC HEARING
2021 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

Notice is given that the 2021 Annual Action Plan (AAP) will be available for public review and comment. Notice is also given that a public hearing will be held to review and discuss the 2021 AAP.

The 2021 AAP describes the City's planned projects and activities to address community and housing development needs with federal HUD Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) funds. These activities are intended to help serve low- to moderate-income households and special needs groups in the City. The 2021 program year will run from October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022.

A draft copy of the 2021 AAP is available for public review and comment starting June 15, 2021 through July 15, 2021.
